



COMPOST SITE REMINDER

Rip-rap rock at the site is not for use by individuals – this is material stockpiled for levee repair work. It may not be purchased or taken from the site.

Dirt, crushed rock and crushed blacktop at the compost site is NOT free for the taking– it may be purchased. Check in with City Hall for prices, and so we know what and when you are taking product.

Yard waste may be dropped off from City of Rushford resident's property. Residents pay an annual \$10.00 charge to make this compost site be available for property owners and for maintenance of public properties. You'll see this annual fee on your March utility bill payable in April.

Often we see the deposit of garbage, plastic, aluminum and general debris dumped at the site. **It is a petty misdemeanor to unlawfully deposit garbage, construction materials or unauthorized debris at the site.** Persons found in violation of the compost site rules are subject to citation/fines.

The site is also subject to being locked down if persons continue to violate the rules or take product without permission.
